### FROM THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT

Thank you to everyone who has been so patient with the drainage project. I am happy to report that a contractor has been approved and work should begin shortly. We hope this helps alleviate some of the flooding on the northeast side of town.

We had a great report from our annual audit. The Village is fiscally sound and in compliance with all regulations.

I want to give a quick reminder that motorized vehicles that are not licensed for public roads are not allowed on village streets. This includes motorbikes, ATV's, etc. Please register your golf carts and follow the ordinance regulations for your safety and the safety of our community. I especially encourage you to watch for walkers, bikes, runners and farm equipment as we roll into harvest season.

#### **Drainage Project Moves Forward**

Six bids were submitted for the detention basin project to be completed on the recently acquired Premier Cooperative ground. The Bid was awarded to Muldeen Excavating. The anticipated date for the project to wrap up is November 17, 2017. This is exciting news for the northeast corner of Philo. The project is to help alleviate the flooding that occurs in that area of town. The excess dirt from the basin will stay on site and may be used as a recreational site and possible sledding hill in the future. The Trees, Parks and Beautification Committee will visit this topic as the project progresses.

### IN OTHER VILLAGE HAPPENINGS

From the meeting minutes:

June - Luke Kirby updated the Board on the Run4Raley event to be held the August 4. Dave Atchley, Village Engineer stated there was only one bid for MFT work. Illiana Construction will be handling the summer road work. Planning Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals continue to work together to streamline the committees. There was an extended discussion of the on-going problem of ATV's on village streets as well as kids driving golf carts.

July - Motion was approved to move forward with the detention basin drainage project. Sourceline Media presented a proposal to update the Village web site. All Board members approved and thought it was a good idea.

**August** - Minutes will be approved at the September board meeting to be held Wednesday, September 13, 2017 in the Eileen Painter Room of the R. E. Franks Meeting Center. #### **BRUSH PICK-UP**

The 2017 seasonal brush pick-up will continue through December 1 weather permitting. Pick-ups are done on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> of each month. If those dates fall on a weekend or holiday, the pick-up will be the following Monday or next day.

Use paper bags for plant material 12 inches or smaller.

Stack limbs that are 12 to 60 inches in length.

Cut items that are longer than 60 inches.

Cut wood limbs that are greater than 6 inches in diameter into 3 foot or less length pieces and separate.

DO NOT PILE BRUSH IN ROAD OR ALLEYWAYS. KEEP IT ON YOUR PROPERTY.

## **Burnings Leaves & Yard Waste**

As the trees turn colors and begin to lose their leaves many people will choose to burn their leaves instead of bag them. **Please be conscious of how it impacts your neighbors. Many people have allergies or sensitivities to smoke.** Residents may burn leaves, sticks and other plants grown or generated in the Village of Philo in a safe manner during daylight hours. Do not burn wet leaves.

## **Golf Cart Registration**



Due to ongoing complaints to Village Trustees, they want to remind residents that the use of ATV's, motorbikes, golf carts without permits and other off-road vehicles are not allowed on village

streets, parks, ball diamonds and other properties of the village. Only inspected golf carts are allowed on the village streets when being operated by a licensed driver. Per a 2009 ordinance, individuals who intend to drive their golf carts on Village streets must obtain a permit from the Village and have their carts inspected, among other criteria.

\*\*Qualifying golf carts must have a maximum attainable speed of 20 miles per hour and be properly equipped.
\*\*Any person who operates a golf cart must be at least 18 years of age and possess a valid driver's license and insurance coverage. The maximum occupancy in the cart is one person per bucket seat or two people per bench seat.

**\*\***Golf carts are to be driven on streets only and from sunrise to sunset.

\*\*The annual permit fee is \$15 for citizens ages 65 years and older and \$30 for all others.

\*\*Golf cart inspection appointments may be made with Trustee Paul Brady at <u>paul-brady@comcast.net</u> or by phone at 684-2540.

# ATV's and other off-road vehicles are NOT allowed on village streets or properties.

Violations are punishable by a fine of not less than \$100 or more than \$500 for each violation.

# **Transient/Solicitation/Peddlers Permits**

The Village has an ordinance for door-to-door sales. Persons wishing to go door-to-door for solicitation are required to obtain a permit from the village office. This does not apply to schools, Scouts and other local fundraising groups. Solicitation hours are 8:00am to 8:00pm and the permit is \$10 per person per day. Solicitors are issued a permit that they must carry with them while in the village and show upon request.
