- Can Openers, Toaster Ovens, Coffee Makers, Toasters, Some Detectors
- Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners, Dehumidifiers or any unit containing Freon
- Stoves, Washer/dryers, Garbage Compactors, Dishwashers, Kitchen white goods
- Fluorescent Lighting or Ballasts
- Desk Office Furniture or Lighting
- Lab and Hospital equipment/devices that contain fluids, oil, mercury or radioactive material
- Biohazards - for example, medical waste including any needles
